She said: "Looking after animals and caring for them has been in my nature for as long as I can remember, which is why I went for a career as a veterinary nurse.

"I am originally from Scarborough but was living in Sussex. I decided I

wanted to open my own cattery and saw this place up for sale online. I went for it and 18 months later am building the business up and have been pleased with the response so far."

Tracy has spent money improving the facilities hugely at the cattery and currently has 13 luxury pens with room for up to 28 cats along with isolation in case any cat is taken ill during their stay.

Tracy added: "It is important that the cat owner feels comfortable and happy when they leave their cats somewhere and I believe they do here.

"My experience as a veterinary nurse is also a comfort to the owners. We have had many customers return so it shows that we are doing a good job and that

customers are pleased with the service.

"We are also a dog free cattery which is something you don't always get and we also have facilities for rabbits and guinea pigs."
